

MARIJUANA (CANNABIS) 2018

Where We Were, Where We Are Now – Where Are We Going?

This workshop will provide a brief overview on cannabis in our culture - our history and the current trends as well as future considerations. The presenter will introduce ideas to challenge current views regarding marijuana used for medicinal treatments and evolving role in the medical community. Other topics will include the different types of pharmaceutical marijuana and statistics on substance abuse in our society.

Participants will:

- 1) Review past and current trends regarding the use of cannabis in our culture.
- 2) Discuss cannabis, CBD and Marinol for medical use.
- 3) Review the types of cannabis used for social or recreational use.
- 4) Compare and contrast statistics related to substance use disorders including alcohol, benzodiazepines, opiates and cannabis.

Peter F. McGoey, MA, LMFT, is a Primary Counselor at the Cottage Health COPE Intensive Outpatient Chemical Dependency and Mental Health Programs in Santa Barbara. He also conducts evaluations in the Trauma Department at Cottage with the SUET team.

Peter has worked for over 35 years in the chemical dependency recovery field. He has been an Adjunct Professor at the University of California at Santa Barbara Continuing Education Department, Antioch University and Santa Barbara City College. He is an assistant men's basketball coach at Santa Barbara City College.

He has led retreats for individuals and family members in recovery from alcoholism or addictions. Peter has completed the training to teach Centering Prayer focusing on 11th step Meditation for those in 12 step program.
